Junior Horse Person Contest

Contest Details

- Candidate must be a junior or family member of the NYSMHS
- Candidate need not own a horse to be eligible
- Entry should include name, address and age of candidate
- Entry and supporting material should be sent to **one** of the judges listed below.
- Each item of the judging criteria is scored on a scale from 1 to 10 with each item evenly weighted. The candidate with the highest score will be awarded the trophy.

Judging Criteria

1. *Horse Activities:*

- Ability to work with and handle horses
- Knowledge of proper care and management of horses
- Performance skill and activities (showing, trail riding, carriage driving, dressage, eventing, etc.)
- Candidate may submit this information or have someone familiar with their activities write a letter.

2. *Community Service (other than horse activities):*

- Participation in community service and organizations. Please be specific

3. *School Activities (academic and extra curricular):*

- This should include a brief written summary by a teacher or advisor, outlining the candidate's academic performance and general citizenship.

4. *Autobiographical Sketch:*

- This must be written by the candidate and should include future plans.

5. *NYSMHS Activities:*

- List activities such as participation in youth clubs (if available) and assistance to the society at shows, meeting, etc.
